Marvin L. Fisher II graduated from Bucknell University in 1958. Mr. Fisher worked from 1958-1963 at Price Waterhouse Public Accounting Firm with time away from 1959-1961 to serve our country as a 1st Lieutenant in the United States Army Finance Corps. Mr. Fisher returned home to work for the Tioga State Bank from 1963-2012. He was named President & CEO of the bank in February 1978 and later became Chairman of the Board of Directors.

Mr. Fisher, along with his wife and family, have been a pillar of the S-VE community for decades. He has served as Trustee on the Robert Packer Hospital Board and Board Member of Tioga United Way. Most recently, Mr. Fisher serves as Director Emeritus of TSB, Trustee of Spencer Historical Society, President of Evergreen Cemetery Association and is an Elder of the Presbyterian church. Mr. Fisher is a member of the S-VE Breakfast Club, the Spencer-Candor Lions Club, the Tioga County Historical Society Museum, Inspire S-VE, and is Chairman of the Arnold and Betty Hilbert Memorial Scholarship Committee. Mr. Fisher received the Legacy Award for Central New York in December 2014.
