The Spencer-Van Etten Central School District has completed the inspection of all schools and buildings to determine compliance with Title Nine, New York State Codes Rules and Regulations, (The Uniform Building Code of New York State). The intent of the inspection is to ensure that each district building does not possess conditions that are favorable for initiating a fire. Each exit of the building, including the access to that exit, was inspected to ensure that there are no obstacles to rapid escape in the event emergency evacuation was necessary. The inspection also raises awareness of fire safety and promotes the integration of fire prevention practice with all building related activities. The inspection included alarms, detectors and other fire safety equipment to ensure proper operation. Overall, the inspection is focused on conditions and practices that promote fire and structural safety to ensure the safety and well-being of all students, employees and visitors.

District and building level safety plans have been developed in accordance with New York State Education Department (SED) guidelines to ensure the continued maintenance of a safe environment for students, employees and visitors. The plans include training and awareness for continued compliance with fire and building codes, as well as, ensures the safety and well-being of occupants of the district buildings. SED regulations require inspections on an annual basis. The district provides for the annual inspections and district personnel assist in the inspection process.
